

# Prayer Guide – Customizable Route NEIGHBOURHOOD PRAYER WALK

*What better way to love our neighbours than to pray together as one church, united in Christ!*

## WHY A PRAYER WALK?

- To intercede for those who have yet to experience the love of God.
- To petition God to bring His righteous justice where oppression reigns.
- To open our eyes to our everyday surroundings, to truly see people, and situations as God does.

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

1. Invite your friends and family.
2. Pick a day and time to venture out into your neighbourhood.
3. Follow the suggestions below.

## PREPARING TO PRAY

1. **Remember who GOD is**...His might, power, love, will, and salvation. "May Your Kingdom come and Your will be done..." (Matt. 6:10)
2. **Remember that you walk in a spiritual wrestling match** against principalities and powers of darkness but not against people or ideas. (Eph. 6:10-18)
3. **Prepare to hear from the Holy Spirit.** Surrender your agenda for the prayer walk and rest in silence listening to God.

## CREATING YOUR ROUTE

- Look at the locations below, choosing 4-5 locations you can either walk or drive to from your home.
- Develop your route and a starting point where you'll meet up with friends & family.



## PRAYING YOUR ROUTE

Follow this pattern of prayer at each location.

- PRAISE** Worship God for who He is. Praise God for His presence and desires for those in this space.
- REPENT** Consider your thought life, actions, attitudes, neglect, assumptions, agenda, and your feeling of superiority or...? Repent as God reveals.
- ASK** Stand in the gap, asking for those who cannot ask God themselves and calling on God to act.
- YIELD** Leave your will and agenda to God. Ask God what He wants you to pray considering our heart's desire should be, "Your Kingdom come, Your will be done...". Rest here, and listen to God's Spirit, speaking those prayers out loud.
